




The mission of MASE is to produce lifelong learners, critical thinkers, effective communicators, and productive members of the global community.

Parents' Right to Know

- •All parents have the right to request the following:
- A teacher's professional qualifications, which includes: state qualifications,
 licensure, certification, waivers
- A teacher's baccalaureate and /or graduate degree, fields of endorsement,
 previous teaching experience
 - A paraprofessional's qualifications
- An assurance that their child's name, address, and telephone listing not be
 released to military recruiters
 - •All parents will receive information on the following:
- Their child's level of achievement in each of the state academic assessments
- Their option to request a transfer to another school within the district if their child
 is the victim of a violent crime at school
- Their right to timely notification that their child has been assigned, or has been
 taught for four or more consecutive weeks by, a teacher who is not highly
 qualified


